What is the cost of the program?

How long does it take to complete the program?

Three and a half days. (Note: Day passes are not an option for this program.)

What days and time are the classes?

Class will be held Monday, July 18 – Thursday, July 21, 2022. Registration and breakfast begins at 8:00 am and concludes each day at 4:30 pm.

Topics include: California Indian History, Tribal Sovereignty, Federal Indian Law, Robert's Rules of Order, MMIW, Indian Child Welfare Act, Intergovernmental Relationships, and more.

Who will be teaching the classes?

We have tailored each class to include experienced community members and experts of the field to instruct and lead the classes. Tribal elders, Tribal leaders, Tribal professionals, Federal Indian Law attorneys, and respected community members are providing their knowledge and expertise to this Certificate Program.

Are there any pre-requisites to take the Certificate Program?

There are no pre-requisites or educational requirements to attend this Certificate Program.

Is this an accredited Certificate Program?

No. This Certificate Program in unaccredited and does not offer college credits or continuing education units.
